What's So Great About Love?

1 Corinthians 13:1-13

1. What did you see or hear God saying to us this weekend from 1 Corinthians 13, what stood out to you? What's your response?
2. Love makes all the difference. Read aloud 1 Corinthians 13:1-3. According to this passage, what kind of a difference does love make?
3. Love looks like Jesus. Read aloud 1 Corinthians 13:4-7. According to this passage, how does love look like Jesus? Where do these character traits and ways of conduct show up in the life of Jesus according to the gospels?
4. Love gets better with age, forever. Read aloud 1 Corinthians 13:8-12. According to this passage, how does love get better with age?
5. Love is the greatest of all. Read aloud 1 Corinthians 13:13. According to this verse, what do the three traits have in common? What's so great about love?
6. 1 Corinthians 13 is the love chapter. It's often read at weddings, but the context of the letter is the worship service. The Corinthian worship services featured the exercise of spiritual gifts, but it was happening without love. It turns out that love is the main ingredient for worship services. How are we doing with the love factor in our worship services? Can you think of a time when you attended a loving worship service. Tell us the story.
7. As Christians, we're all still growing in our love for God and neighbor. From what you hear God saying to you through His word right now, how can we pray for you. Take time to pray for the person to your right.
